

Primary I and Primary II

The Primary I and II classes (First and Second Grade) meet on Monday afternoons at 4:30pm. They are specifically designed to introduce our younger children to the joys of being Jewish. These students learn about the holidays, the Synagogue, Israel, Tzedakah, and introduced to basic Hebrew. The primary grades attend Jr. Congregation.

Aleph through Hey

Aleph (Third Grade) through Hey (Seventh Grade) classes meet twice a week on Mondays at 4:30 p.m. and Thursdays at 4:30pm. Our older students continue to learn about mitzvot, holidays, Jewish values, Torah and Israel. The students learn the Friday night service. As they become more skilled, they assume more responsibility so that by the age of Bar/Bat Mitzvah, they are able to independently lead much of the service. All of our elementary students attend Jr. Congregation.

Vav through Het

Vav (Eighth Grade) through Het (Tenth Grade) classes meet twice a month on Mondays at 6:30 pm. Jewish Law, Jewish Humor, Drama and Holocaust are a few of the electives that our students may choose. The small classes provide individual attention for the students.

Individualized attention is available to every student to encourage each child to achieve his/her highest level of performance. Our individual sessions are designed to help students build and enhance basic skills and encourage a positive attitude about their Religious School experience.
